Who is the BBC?

The BBC is the UK's incumbent broadcaster and a leader in digital content distribution globally

What are the Business Requirements?

The “movies” section of the BBC website enjoys particularly high demand traffic so the BBC needed a robust and scalable solution to outsource their streaming Video On Demand content delivery in both Real Media and Windows Media formats.

A further requirement was for an easy to use uploading tool and platform level mechanism to allow content suppliers to upload content independently, for subsequent review and publishing by the BBC.

What is the Interoute solution?
